### Other Markings

ch. - choke: hit the cymbal and then grab it to mute the sound

loose hi hat - lift up on the pedal slightly to make a loose sound when hit w/ stick

tight hi hat - hold the pedal closed tightly to make a tight sound when hit w/ stick
